



Ness Radio is the first collaborative webradio broadcasted from Morocco. Founded in 2008 in Marrakech by **Younes Duret** and **Wattfutchureez**, the project first met the need to share some alternative and eclectic music, beyond boundaries and frontiers. Growing quickly, the **Ness Crew** now gathers more than 30 artists, music lovers, and show hosts. As many talents and ambitions who explore the latest trends of house, electro, jazz, soul, and hip-hop from Marrakech, London, Paris, and even LA.

6 years after its creation and about 6 centuries after **Ibn Battuta's** expeditions, the radio now presents its very first compilation called **Kafilah 2.0**. Ibn Battuta symbolizes traveling, being in motion, meeting people and sharing cultures. He brought together the individual and the universal at a time when men, goods, and knowledge travelled across the Mediterranean, Africa, Orient, and Asia, essentially thanks to the *Kafilah* (the caravan).

In sync with the digital era, **Ness Radio** thus proposes a full music experience through a platform for exchange that allows sharing and encourages creation, without borders. Most of all, **Kafilah 2.0** is a collaborative project that gathers 16 artists on the theme: "Maghreb, Orient, and West". Amongst them: **Imhotep**, producer of **IAM**, **J.Kid**, one of the trendiest French beat maker, **Woodini**, **Abstract Butta Fingas**, **Cheikh Mehdi**, and **Nissae**. Finally, talented Moroccan graphic designer **Zahra Sebti** signed the visuals to complete the project.

Ness Radio offers what sounds like the soundtrack of 2014 in a compilation rich in oriental influences, Egyptian divas reminiscences, jazzy curls, memories of Bollywood, and abstract hip-hop.
